5. IMPORTANT

The Summer Schools of Slavonic Studies offering **Czech language courses** are organised by several public universities in the Czech Republic: **Charles University** (Faculty of Arts, **Prague**), Charles University **Institute for Language and Preparatory Studies in Poděbrady**, **Masaryk University** (Faculty of Arts, **Brno**), **Palacký University in Olomouc** (Faculty of Arts, **Olomouc**), **University of South Bohemia** in České Budějovice (Faculty of Arts, **České Budějovice**) and the **University of West Bohemia in Pilsen**. The courses are held during the summer months (July – September), their length ranges from 2 to 4 weeks depending on the course content determined by each Summer School

and are designed for foreign students, teachers, translators and interpreters and other experts active in the field of Czech/Slavonic studies. Due to their broad scope they are, however, open to anyone else who is interested in the Czech language, literature, history and culture. The Summer Schools offer language courses at various levels of proficiency, seminars on the Czech literature, culture and history, free-time activities including theatrical, musical and dance performances, trips etc.
